

# New York and New Jersey: Price Movements of Top Exports and Other Highlights



The combined exports from New York and New Jersey totaled \$109.2 billion in 2019, down 6.7 percent from the previous year. New York exported \$73.3 billion in 2019 and total exports from New Jersey were \$36.0 billion. Prices for non-medical miscellaneous manufacturing exports increased from May to August. The price indexes for computer and electronic product manufacturing, chemical manufacturing, and primary metal manufacturing increased over the same period.



## Top Six New York and New Jersey Exports by Trade Dollar Value, 2019




- Miscellaneous manufacturing accounted for 20.9 percent of the total \$109.2 billion in export trade dollar value from New York and New Jersey.
- Chemical manufacturing exports from New York and New Jersey accounted for 6.9 percent of the industry's 2019 U.S. exports.
- Exports from New York and New Jersey accounted for a 6.0-percent share of total U.S. computer and electronic product manufacturing exports.

## U.S. Export Price Indexes: Miscellaneous Manufacturing


- Miscellaneous manufacturing export prices advanced 0.2 percent from May to August.
- The increase over the 3 months ended in August was the largest advance in the index since October 2019.
- Prices for export miscellaneous manufacturing fell 2.3 percent over the past 12 months.





### U.S. Export Price Indexes: Chemical Manufacturing

- Export prices for chemical manufacturing exports rose 1.5 percent over the 3 months ended in August.
- The 3-month increase in the price index for chemical manufacturing was the largest since rising 2.1 percent during the period ended April 2018.
- From August 2019 to August 2020, export prices for chemical manufacturing declined 3.0 percent.



### U.S. Export Price Indexes: Computer and Electronic Product Manufacturing



- Export prices for computer and electronic product manufacturing rose 0.4 percent from May to August.
- The price index for computer and electronic product manufacturing exports increased 1.0 percent over the past 12 months.
- The 12-month advance in computer and electronic product manufacturing prices was the largest since the index increased 1.0 percent over the year ended February 2018.

### U.S. Export Price Indexes: Machinery Manufacturing

- The price index for machinery manufacturing exports declined 0.1 percent from May to August.
- A 1.6-percent drop in prices for engine, turbine, and power transmission equipment manufacturing drove the 3-month decline in machinery manufacturing prices.
- Prices for machinery manufacturing exports advanced 0.2 percent over the 12 months ended in August.
